Attendance roll call was taken.

Ms. Jacobs moved to approve the regular session report from the January 21, 2022 Strategic Planning and Governance Committee meeting. Mr. Findlay seconded. Motion carried.

Ms. Stegmann updated the committee on the progress of the strategic plan.
